POMA PUBLIC MEETING:

The Special Board meeting was followed by a public meeting which was attended by 25 people who signed the register. The following issues were raised and fully discussed:

- 1) The Budget and 3 Year Business Plans (2024/2025/2026). This information is freely available on the POMA website and any queries in this regard should be directed to the POMA office.
- 2) Fees for 2024: were presented.
- 3) Maintenance issues: The maintenance and irrigation of the Public Open Space at the East Basin was discussed.
- 4) **Alterations to existing jetties**: These, including Afridock Ride-On additions, MUST be approved and authorized by POMA prior to installation.
- 5) **Dredging:** An update on the dredging operations in 2023 was given and the requirement and process for permit renewal applications was outlined in detail.
- 6) Water quality: The quality of the water in the marina was questioned. From the floor, Gerhard Louw (a Trustee of St Helena Bay Water Quality Trust), indicated that it is currently safe for recreational use.
- 7) **Illegal netting in the marina**: POMA is not a Law Enforcement Agency and has neither the capacity nor the mandate to act in this regard. POMA can only support and where possible facilitate reporting of these activities.
- 8) Repairs to the retaining walls and public walkways was discussed.
- 9) **Erosion at the Admiral Island access bridge**: It was pointed out that erosion of the bases of the bridge to the Island was concerning. POMA will raise this with Johan Moolman at the next Board meeting.
